Hope you remember the date of birth of the Indian Social Science Academy (ISSA) which is August 15, 1974, University of Allahabad. It will complete its 50 years of life on August 15, 2024. The General Body and the Executive Council have resolved to celebrate ISSA Golden Jubilee from August 15, 2024 to August 15, 2025. **First Golden Jubilee Celebration** function will be held on August 14-16, 2024 at Allahabad (now Prayagraj), the birthplace of ISSA. The celebration will be held in all states, responsibility of which is expected to be shouldered by the members from respective states. Another major function will be held during the 48th Indian Social Science Congress, February 03-07, 2025 at Swami Vivekananda University, Kolkata.

The Executive Council has constituted National Golden Jubilee Organising Committee and Golden Jubilee Organising Committee for the purpose. Members are welcome to join either of the Committees and also form an Organising Committee in their States.

The Executive Council also proposes to create **new chairs for high order theoretical/policy research, memorial lectures, Gold Medal Awards** in the name of eminent scientists, creative thinkers, philosophers and social activists. **Generous donations with details of proposal are welcome from all members and well-meaning people of India.**

As you know ISSA does not have its building for its headquarters. The Executive Council, therefore, proposes to construct its building on 100'X100' land offered by Peoples Council of Education to it. We need to raise sufficient fund for it. We, therefore, request you kindly (a) to donate for the 'Building Fund' generously and (b) try to raise more fund through your friends and connections.

You are also welcome to buy valuable books, journals, monographs and Social Science Abstracts on 40% discount for your personal/institutional library.

All donations are exempt from Income Tax under 80(G) Act of Income Tax Act. An effort is being made for obtaining 100% tax exemption.
